



Notification of processing of personal data

The Royal Danish Ballet - Summer School

1. Processing of your personal data and recipients or categories of recipients

The Royal Danish Theatre collects and processes information in order to 1) assess your application to take part in the Royal Danish Ballet - Summer School and 2) offer you the most appropriate service level during the course.

We are responsible for the processing of your data. We ensure that this is done on an informed and correct basis.

The Royal Danish Theatre discloses data to the Theatre's data processors. We have entered into data processing agreements with data processors and supervise the data processors' compliance with the data processing agreements according to applicable rules in this regard.

2. The legal basis for processing your personal data

Your data is processed under the authority of section 2(4) of Act no. 246 of 18 March 2020 on performing arts, of Article 6(1), point (a) of the General Data Protection Regulation¹, and of Article 9(2), point (a) of the General Data Protection Regulation and of section 7(1) of the Danish Data Protection Act.²

The processing of your personal data is thus based exclusively on your consent.

3. What information do we process about you?

In connection with the submission of your application and registration to the Royal Danish Ballet - Summer School, we will collect and process the following information about you:

- Name, address, e-mail and telephone of the participant and guardians
- Participant's date of birth, nationality, current school
- Information about the participant's experience with ballet training and other dance styles
- Video presentation of the participant
- A headshot for the participant
- Information about health condition
- Any other information you feel relevant to the assessment of the participant's situation/experience

We store your personal data for as long as the data are necessary for the purpose for which they were collected. When there is no longer a legal or administrative need, the data will be discarded (erased). You may at any time withdraw your consent to our processing of your personal data, and we will then erase the personal data when we are obliged to do so, see paragraph 5 directly below.

4. Specific information related to pictures taken during the course

By accepting this declaration, you consent to the Royal Danish Theatre's publication of pictures, video and audio recordings of you and/or children of whom you have custody on the Theatre's analogue and digital communication platforms (in particular the Theatre's printed publications, website www.kglteater.dk and on Facebook and Instagram). The consent is voluntary, and it is therefore up to you to decide whether to consent to the publication.

The purpose of the Royal Danish Theatre's publication of pictures or video recordings is to provide information and documentation of the activities of the Theatre, including for marketing purposes.

When publishing pictures and video recordings, the Royal Danish Theatre will process the following data:

- Your and/or the child's full name
- Pictures or video recordings in which you and/or the child appears



5. The right to withdraw the consent

You may choose to withdraw your consent at any time. If you wish to withdraw your consent, please contact the Royal Danish Theatre using the contact information set out in paragraph 7.

If you choose to withdraw your consent, your application will be withdrawn, and you will not be able to take part in the course. The collected information will be kept in anonymous form for up to five years for statistical purposes.

If you withdraw your consent, the Royal Danish Theatre will as soon as possible in general remove or anonymize your personal data obtained on the basis of the consent. However, this does not apply if the Royal Danish Theatre for other reasons (for example, as part of the Theatre's exercise of authority) have legal grounds that prohibits the removal, but in that case, you will be notified.

6. Your rights

You are entitled to access the personal data that we process about you as well as certain other information. In addition, you are in certain situations entitled to object to our otherwise lawful processing of your personal data. You are entitled to have incorrect data about you rectified. In exceptional cases, you are entitled to have data about you erased before the time provided for our general erasure.

You are in certain situations entitled to have the processing of your personal data restricted. If you are entitled to restriction of the processing of your personal data, we are in future only entitled to process data - except for storage - with your consent or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims, or for the protection of individuals, or for important reasons of public interest.

Finally, you are also entitled to data portability. The right only concerns the data covered by this declaration of consent and which you yourself have provided to the Royal Danish Theatre, and only data that are processed automatically.

identify you and reply to your inquiry. We will answer your inquiry as soon as possible and not later than within a month.

7. Complaints to the Danish Data Protection Agency

You are entitled to lodge a complaint with the Danish Data Protection Agency if you do not agree with our processing of your personal data. The contact details of the Danish Data Protection Agency are available at www.datatilsynet.dk.
